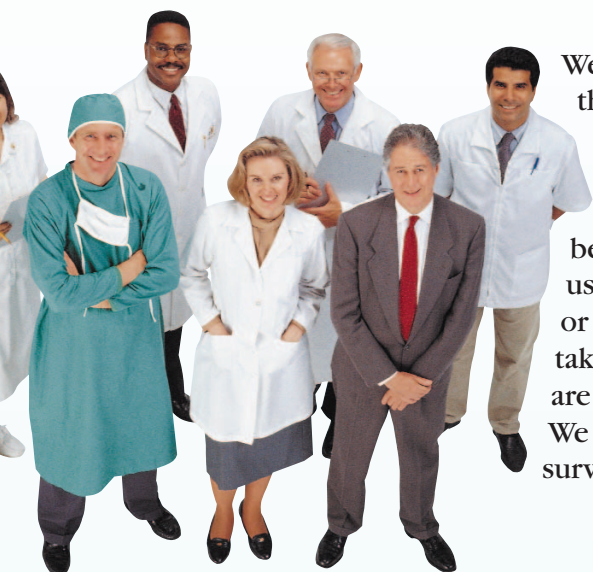
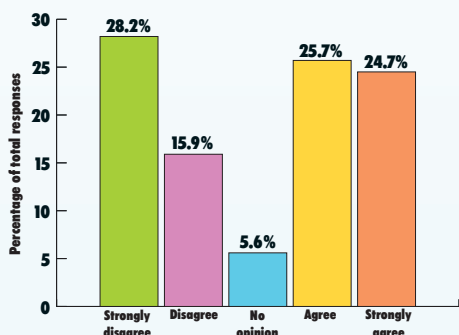


# Physician opinion survey

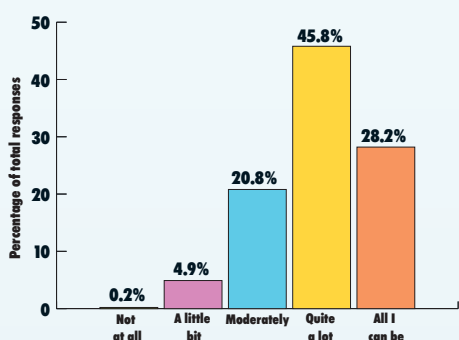

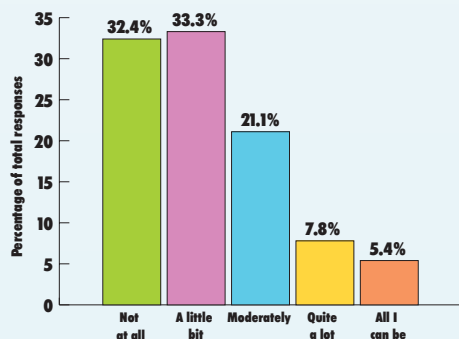
1. I am in favor of a government-sponsored health insurance plan.



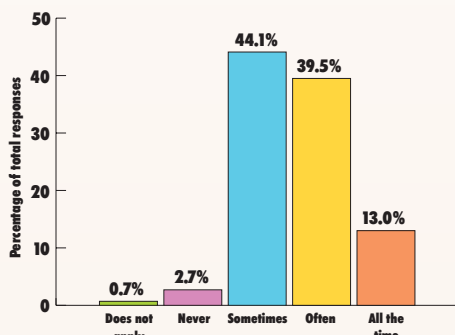
2. I am following the news about national health care reform



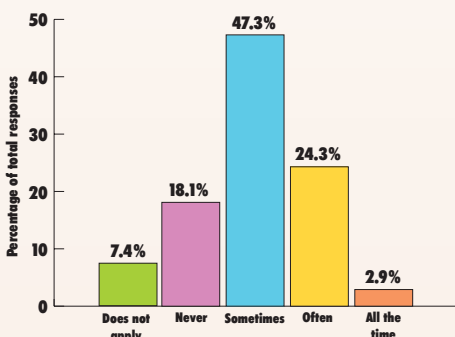
3. I am actively involved with health care reform.



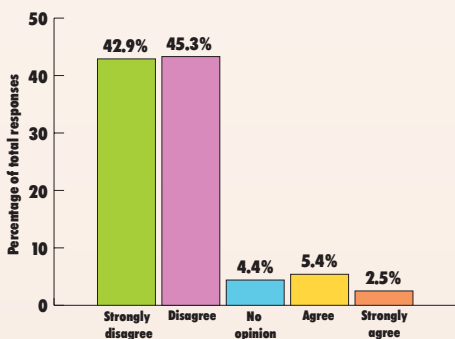
4. I have conversations with my physician colleagues about health care reform.



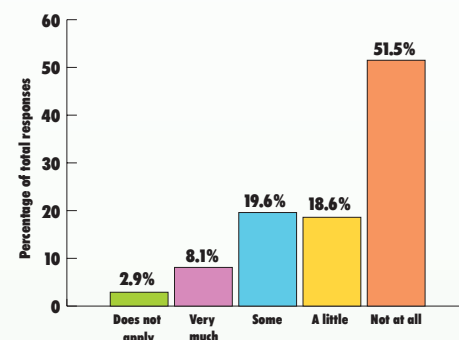
5. I have conversations with my patients about health care reform.



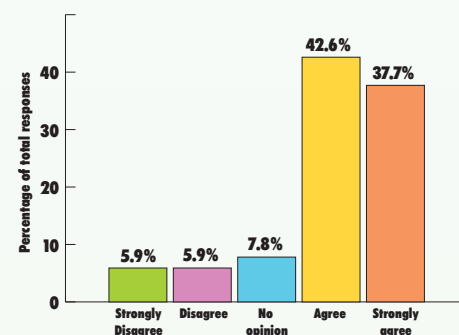
6. I feel health care reform will have no meaningful effect on my practice of medicine.



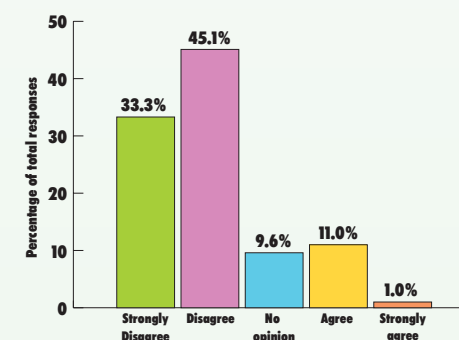
7. I feel pressured to keep my opinions about health care reform to myself.



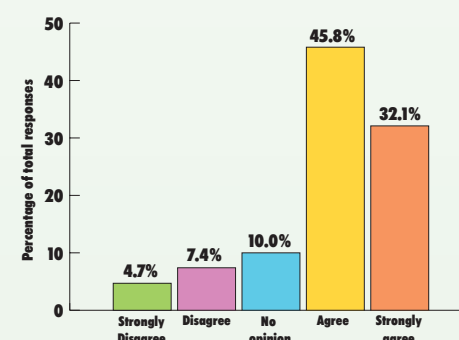
8. National health care reform should include an overhaul of the influence health plans exert on the practice of medicine.
